The following questions and journal prompts are provided for you to prayerfully reflect on Jesus' invitation for us to be all in for the Kingdom of God. As you consider these questions, may you courageously lean into the invitations of God with a consecrated heart and life of devotion.

1. What is quietly ruling my heart right now?

- When I consider my thoughts, anxieties, and daydreams, what seems to carry the most weight?
- Is it comfort, success, approval, pleasure, control, security?
- Or is it trust, obedience, generosity, surrender, and love?

2. Where am I living divided?

- Are there compartments of my life that I keep separate from my “spiritual life?”
- Are there areas of my life where I’m justifying, minimizing, or hiding from God or others?
- Are there patterns that reflect the values of the world more than the character of Christ?

3. What does my use of time, money, and energy reveal about my heart’s allegiance?

- How am I stewarding my time in recent days and weeks?
- How am I spending the financial resources entrusted to me? How am I viewing money?
- What are the areas that get my best and most focused energy?

4. What would “all in” look like for me right now?

- What is the next step of faithfulness and surrender? What might God be inviting me into?
- Is there repentance needed?
- Is there forgiveness to extend?
- Is there a harmful habit to confront?
